

TIMER – Training activities

Training activities supported by TIMER are dedicated to young scientists within TIMER, and aim to foster collaboration among partners. Two types of research promotion opportunities are available:

- A. *Technology transfer*
 - B. *Collaborative programme*
- A. The “Technology transfer” grant supports travel and accommodation expenses for acquiring special skills by short visits of laboratories with the relevant expertise, preferably within TIMER, but if required also outside TIMER (e.g.; TARKINAID and TRIAD laboratories).
- B. The “Collaborative programme” short-term fellowships supports travel and accommodation expenses to spend a maximum of 6 months in an TIMER partner laboratory for carrying out a collaborative project.

Proposals should be submitted by e-mail using the appropriate forms (rates for each country are listed in “Guidelines for expenses reimbursement”) to:

Each proposal will be evaluated by the TIMER Training committee (Uguccioni, Locati, Teixeira) within a month from submission.

The “*scientific visit report*” signed by the responsible person in the guest laboratory, as well as by the visiting scientist should be sent **within 1 month** from the end of the period, together with **copy of tickets or receipts** for travel expenses to:
